### **CLASS REQUIREMENTS**

### **CLASS THEMES**

### ATTENDENCE POLICY

Class attendance and participation are required.

A make-up assignment may be assigned if absence occurs.

**More than three unexcused absences** will need to be discussed with Fr. Ron to see if student can continue with class.

## STUDENT BEHAVIOR POLICY

Students must act with respect and show Christian love to all of their fellow classmates. If a student personally attacks or demeans another for *any* reason, he or she will be asked to leave for the day. Their parent/s or guardian/s will be notified to pick up the student. This will count towards an unexcused absence.

### **DRESS CODE POLICY**

Students will dress modestly not only for themselves, but for students around them.

- Shorts/skirts/dresses must not be shorter than fingertip length when the student's arm is placed at his
  or her side.
- No tube tops, muscle shirts, midriff styles, or revealing necklines.
- Clothing will not be excessively tight and must fit properly.
- Inappropriate language will not be tolerated.

## **CELL PHONE POLICY**
